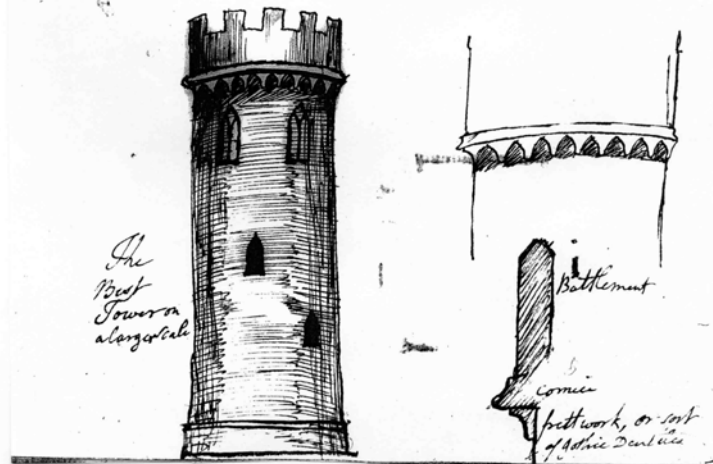
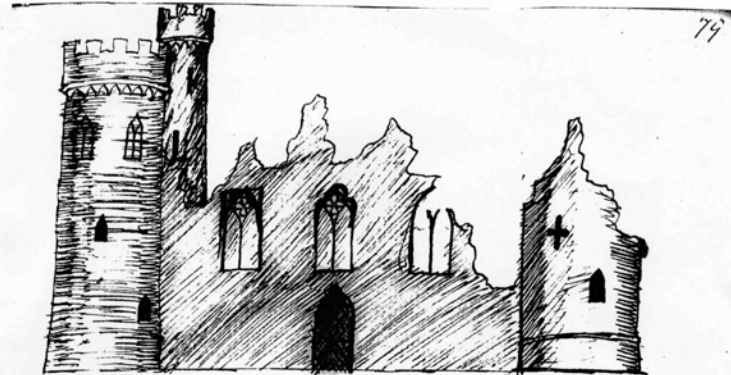
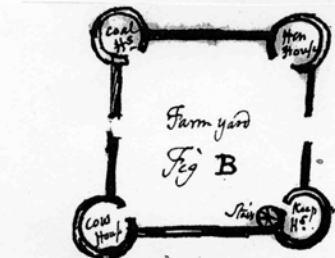

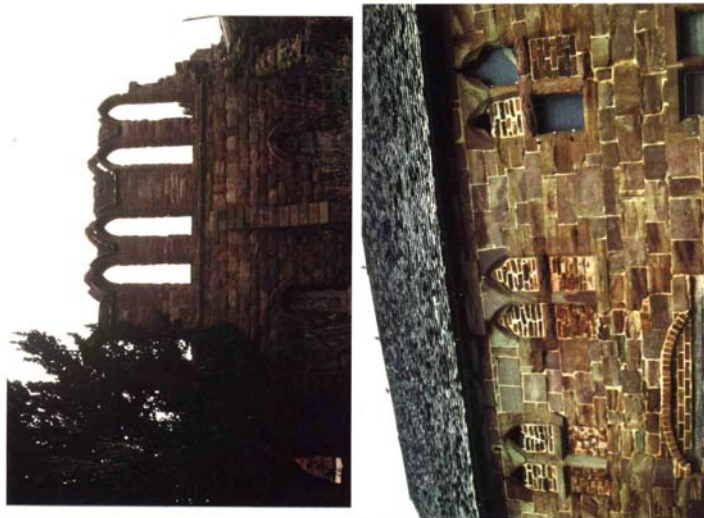

Grundrissplan St. Mary's Abbey, Halesowen

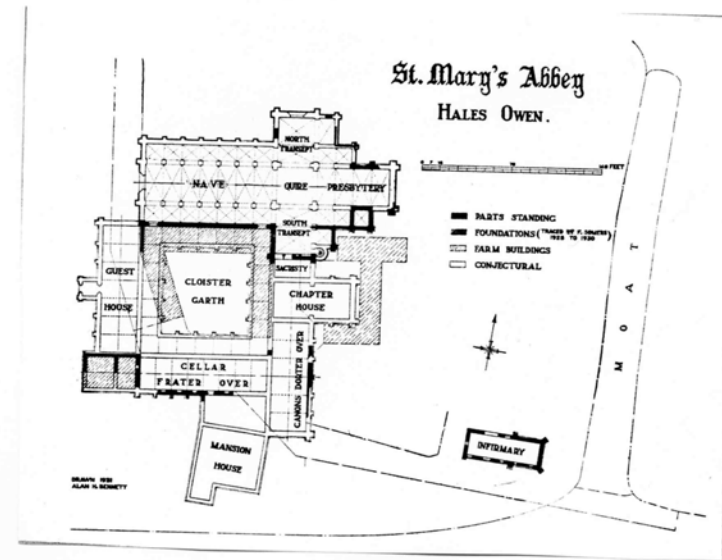
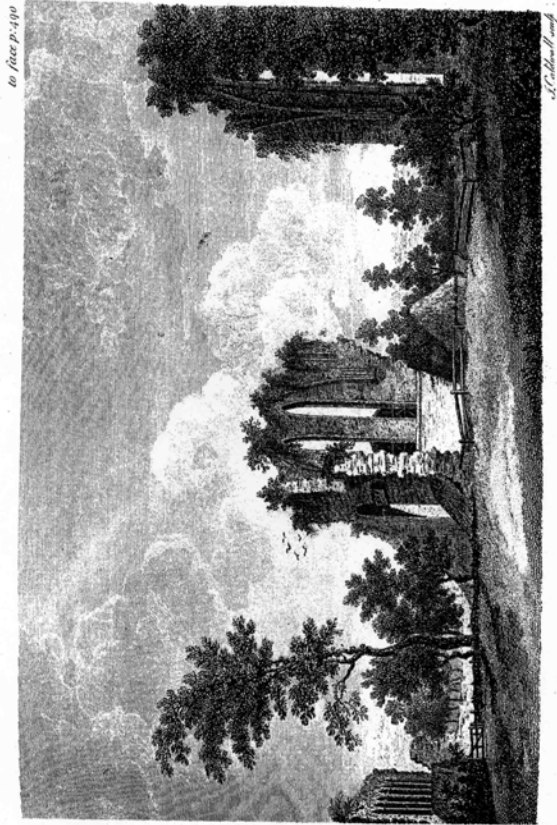

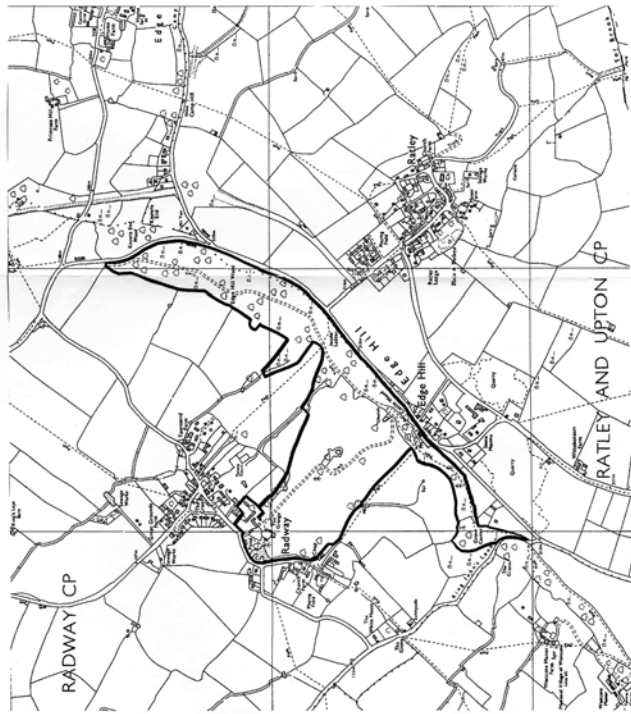
**NOTES**

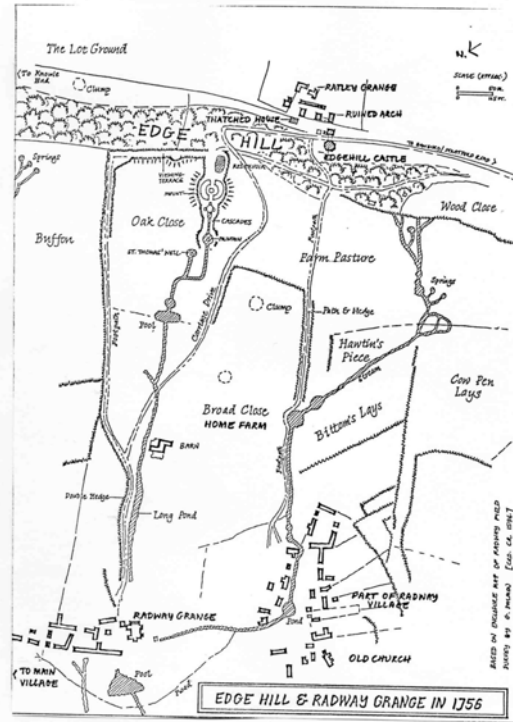


Abb. 194 Radway Grange, Sanderson Millers Wohnhaus, Zeichnung frühes 19. Jh.

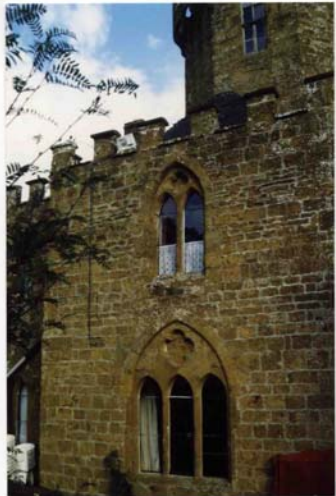
