



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## Doubly excited helium: from strong correlation to chaos



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Cover: The bar diagram along the binding energy axis represents an experimental photoemission spectrum measured with  $h\nu = 76.2$  eV, with the satellites  $n = 2$  to 4 representing the ionic final states of  $\text{He}^+(n)$ . The solid curve through the data points represents partial cross section  $\sigma_3$  below the ionization threshold  $I_5$ , which can be derived from a large number of such photoemission spectra (not shown here) recorded at different photon energies.
