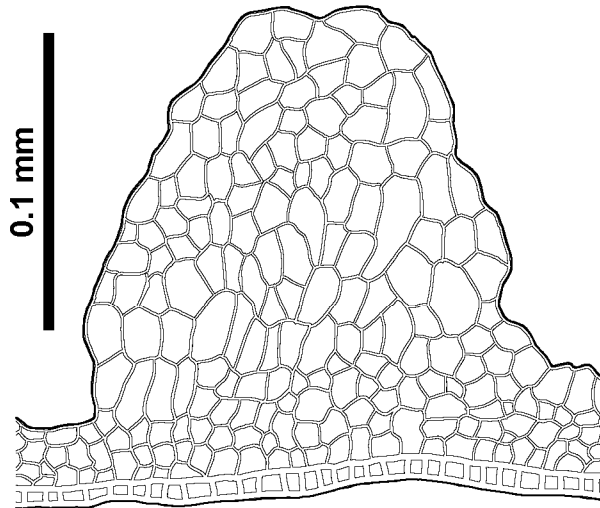
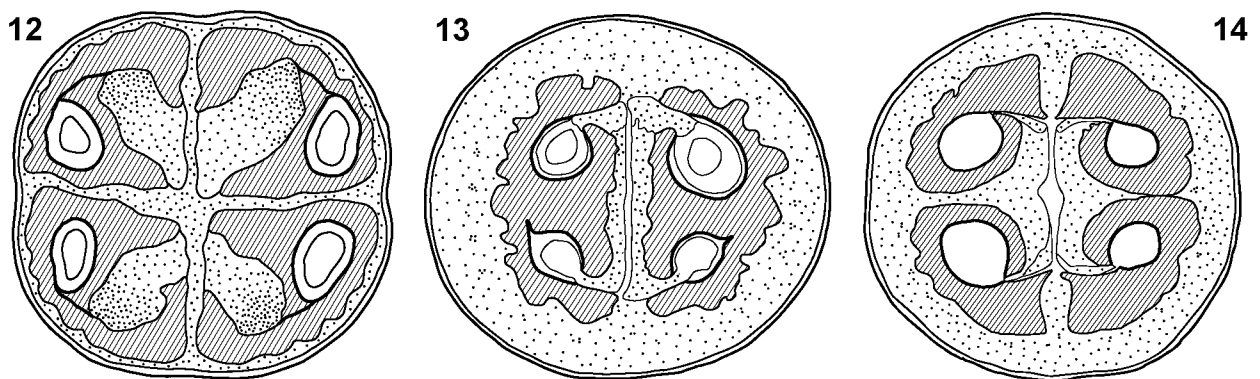


Figure 7-11: Single abaxial ridge of an *Ehretia acuminata* endocarpid in transverse section (redrawn from KHALEEL 1977).
